# OAC SOUTHBANK

Situated in the heart of Southbank, this campus has been architecturally designed to dazzle children's senses, invite curiosity and inspire.

Together with architects *4d Architecture and Design* and *Elsie+Betty*, we have created exciting play and learning spaces built specifically for the development of nursery, toddler and kindergarten children.

The campus is spaciouly set across two levels with an expansive outdoor area flowing seamlessly from the learning rooms. The mezzanine level has been transformed into a haven for children aged 0-2 years with dedicated nursery trained Educators and separate, calm sleep rooms.
